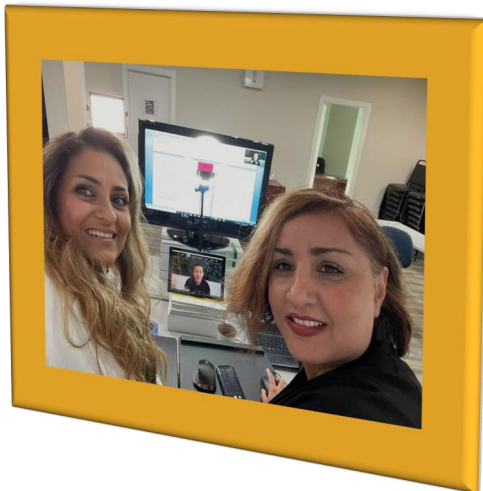

HOW WE WORK!

Members, Volunteers, Advisors, and Directors of SACIF get together regularly to think, plan and make their thoughts happen within the spectrum of the goals and vision of SACIF. Enhancing the quality of the work is an every day effort!

Biweekly meeting of the CEO, Public Relation Officer, Marketing Officer, and IT Officer to follow up the decisions made in monthly Board of Directors (BOD) meetings, and preparing the required documentation, such as financial reports and preliminary reports on issues needed to be considered by and brought to the attention of BOD and members and, any other high priority tasks like, working on the quarterly newsletters.

Monthly meeting of BOD to review and discuss the progress of the work flow and to talk about the children being sponsored and finding more ways to sponsor more vulnerable children, identifying priorities ahead and future plans, making sure SACIF is following the activities in accordance with the bylaws and requirements of application regulations and pertinent regulatory bodies such as the BC Societies Act and the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA), to the best of their ability with the advice received from advisors, auditors and lawyers who are working as consultants to SACIF.

Indeed, it is of paramount significance to SCAIF to ensure they are doing the work in full compliance with the rules and regulations set forth by the BC Societies Act and the CRA and keeping all activities in accordance to the applicable Canadian and international law. SACIF has been working with a group of advisors and hired a lawyer office to receive consultation on how the job needs to be carried out.

Coordinating with SACIF's Board of Advisors meetings to obtain their advises and recommendations.

Striving to find more charities and educational entities for which SACIF could be of any help or could help SACIF.

What we have conducted in line with SACIF's vision lately:

Continuing our support for World Orphanage Foundation (WOF) and Empower Nepali Girls (ENG), our partners, and finding more sponsors for deprived children in Afghanistan, Nepal, and Tanzania



Partnership with WOF on potable water well construction project in Kochi Abad in which about 2000 poor families live.



Contributed to a project of provision of food to very poor families/ kids in Afghanistan.

Partnered with WOF to source powdered milk for malnourished mothers who are not able to breastfeed their children; some babies were lost because of the weakness of their mothers.



Helping UNICEF to assist children in Canada and globally.



Because Hunger Doesn't Take a Weekend Off

Started supporting the Back Buddies program of the Community First Foundation organization in Vancouver which puts food on the tables of children in less fortunate BC families over the weekends, knowing that BC has one of the highest child poverty rate in Canada with 20% of children living below the poverty line, and strangely enough, the fact that 3 in 10 BC children do not have enough food to eat!
