### KIDS DYING OF HUNGER IN AFGHANISTAN

SACIF Donated **\$1000** to WOF to provide food for so many innocent kids dying of hunger in Afghanistan recently.

As winter sets in, nearly 23 million people -- more than half the population -- are facing extreme levels of hunger, according to the <u>United Nations</u>. At least <u>a million children</u> under 5 are at risk of dying from starvation.

### **WORLD DAY OF WAR ORPHANS**

World Day of War Orphans 2022: The World Day of War Orphans is observed on January 6 every year. The day aims to raise awareness about children who have been orphaned due to wars. The objective of the day ensures to voice out the predicament of war orphans and highlight the emotional, social, and physical challenges children face while growing up.

According to unicef.org, "There were nearly 140 million orphans globally in 2015, including 61

million in Asia, 52 million in Africa, 10 million in Latin America and the Caribbean, and 7.3 million in Eastern Europe and Central Asia."

The evidence clearly shows that millions of children have become orphaned; the vast majority of orphans are living with a surviving parent, grandparent, or other family members. 95 percent of all orphans are over the age of five. Orphans are relatively fewer in numbers in developed countries. But, in places that have been subject to wars and great epidemics, their numbers are considerably higher.



On this important day, SACIF also remembers orphaned children around the world who were orphaned as a result of the war and published a video on its social media.



# SACIF CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE ON WORLD CHILDREN'S DAY



Dr. Peyman Raoofi SACIF's Chairman made a statement for this very important day. In his speech, he talked about mental health that these days affected children and the young generation more than ever. Mental health issues that now raised 13 precents during this pandemic.

He explained how education has a significant role in improving children's mental health.

School, community and family will shape the mental health of children. So, it is urgent to protect vulnerable children and care for 3 most important factors, Health, Education, and Social Education which could be provided by schools.







# Two Major Projects that SACIF Contributed to UNICEF

# KIND School & Accessing Children to nutrition and vaccines



In addition to monthly donation to UNICEF Canada, these are their two major projects for which SACIF has donated \$20K (10k for each project), as described by UNICEF:

- 1) The project called KIND Schools that supports students in Malawi to have the right to an education, providing them with the tools and resources needed for a successful day. The global disruption from COVID-19 presents an opportunity for a once-in-a-lifetime transformation in the schools, so that every child learns the skills they need to succeed in life, school and work. UNICEF is looking to invest in quality education and skills development to ensure a whole generation of children are not left behind.
- 2) As many as 811 million people faced hunger in 2020. Since then, a combination of rising global hunger levels, increased conflict, the continued effects of the climate crisis and the COVID-19 pandemic has now turned the malnutrition crisis into a once-in-a-generation threat. We are looking to ensure that children have access to nutrition and vaccines they need to have a healthy childhood.
